

KAREN NEWKIRK'S **STEWARDSHIP CORNER**

Since Fr. Gary is on pilgrimage to Poland and it is almost time for our annual stewardship appeal, here are answers to some "Frequently Asked Questions" about Stewardship.

Why is there a Stewardship Appeal every year?

An Annual Stewardship Appeal is a time for us as Christians to take time to reflect on the gifts that we have been given, and to prayerfully discern how we have been faithful stewards of these gifts. We also want to reflect on where we have fallen short in receiving and sharing these gifts. It is a chance to ask, "Where is the Lord asking me to give of myself in a greater way this upcoming year?" It is a time for us as individuals, families, parishes and as a diocese/archdiocese to recommit ourselves to Christ by offering all that we are, and all that we have as a gift back to Him, the giver of all good gifts.

Why is it necessary to complete a stewardship commitment form each year?

"Why do we have to fill out a form?' If we look at things logically, we realize that whenever we put things in writing and put our name to a form, the chances are we are going to fulfill it. If we just 'promise' to do something, we can always rationalize away that promise very quickly for all kinds of different reasons. If we have that form, we know what we have committed and are expected to follow through." Msgr. Thomas McGread

The completed pledge forms are truly a gift that the parishioners collectively give to the entire parish family. The truth is that God has given each of us different gifts. The gifts are not given to us exclusively for our own benefit, but are given for the good of the whole. When I share the gifts I have received, the Body of Christ is strengthened and glorified. When I hoard the gifts I have received, the Body of Christ suffers.




Join us for the monthly Public Rosary in the Rosary Garden at 12:00PM. We will gather for fellowship and food after.






ST. MARY'S FOOD KITCHEN • NOVEMBER 6 9:30AM, Off-Site





In 1882, Father Michael McGivney formed the Knights of Columbus in New Haven, CT. The goal of the group was to care for the poor and the widowed, to make its members better Catholics and better Americans, and to contribute to the spiritual and civic well-being of the church and the local communities of its members. It was a response, under Father McGivney's leadership, to the anti-Catholic sentiments and industrial abuses of the era in which he lived. McGivney contracted tuberculosis and eventually succumbed, at the age of 38, to the disease in August 1890. Widely mourned, his death did not signal the end of the Knights of Columbus, which because of its structure as a lay, fraternal organization (as devised by McGivney), could carry on its work after his death.

RESPECT FOR LIFE CORNER: A POST CHRISTIAN AGE?

On September 23, a federal judge in North Dakota issued a sharply worded opinion granting a preliminary injunction prohibiting federal regulations requiring religious employers to grant leave and other accommodations for abortions. The Diocese of Bismarck and an association representing 87 other Dioceses and 1400 other catholic organizations challenged the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission's (EEOC) action. They argued that the EEOC betrayed the original intent of the law which was to protect pregnant women, postpartum mothers and their babies. It was not intended to force religious employers to engage in actions supportive of abortion. The judge granted the injunction because the religious organizations were likely to prevail in their lawsuit. He held the EEOC's rule would force members to choose between expressing sincerely held beliefs and compliance with government edicts. This would cause irreparable harm to them. He wrote: "It is a precarious time for people of religious faith in America. It has been described as a post-Chistian Age." In a footnote to his opinion, the judge wrote: 'Time and again the First Amendment rights of American citizens has been the subject of litigation in federal court. Organizations must continually sue to keep the federal government from infringing on basic and wellsettled rights to freedom of religion."
