



FATHER GARY PENNINGS PASTOR'S CORNER



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Jesus was born at a time when the Roman Empire, one of the most powerful empires in all human history, reigned. Through most of Christian history, the western world was ruled by kings (or queens). When Jesus proclaimed the Gospel in Galilee and Judea, the people understood the concept of a monarchy, a kingdom.

Furthermore, Jesus' first public words in St. Mark's Gospel refer to a kingdom. Jesus said, "This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel."

Thus, Jesus is announcing a new kind of kingdom, not one of this world alone; not one dominated by human power, wealth or violence. Rather, as the Preface for the Mass on the Solemnity of Christ the King states, "an eternal and universal kingdom, a kingdom of truth and life; a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace."

We complete the Year of Grace 2024 with this great feast day of Christ the King. How appropriate it is that we should conclude the liturgical year by honoring our Lord Jesus Christ under the title, "King of the Universe."

This world-wide Catholic feast day was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925. The Holy Father established this feast to emphasize the true kingship of Christ, in response to growing secularism and secular ultra-nationalism that was emerging in Europe following the fall of European kingdoms after World War I. The Pope decided to establish the solemnity to point to a king "of whose kingdom there shall be no end."

As the universal King, the Lord Jesus deserves allegiance, honor and obedience. He is a King motivated by love for His subjects. As members of His Kingdom, we are called to be good subjects and give all honor and fidelity to Jesus Christ, the King.





Those individuals should familiarize themselves with the following qualifications for these positions: A person baptized and confirmed and at least 16 years of age; If married, then in a marriage recognized by the Catholic Church; Love of the Eucharist with faith in the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist; Desire to grow in personal relationship with Christ in the Eucharist; A registered member of Ascension Parish; Weekly participation in the Eucharist; Willingness to serve as needed and available; Commitment to serve as assigned or to obtain a replacement. Those who do not meet these qualifications should discuss their situation directly with Fr Gary. We are in need of dedicated people in both ministries and ask that you prayerfully discern if you are being called to serve.



SOLEMNITY OF THE IMMACULATE CONCEPTION (HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION) • DECEMBER 9

Masses: 7:00AM, 8:00AM (School Mass), 12:00PM and 7:00PM, Church

Monday, December 9 is a Holy Day of Obligation celebrating the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception. After consultation with the Holy See, the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops has announced that whenever the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary is transferred from Sunday, December 8 to Monday, December 9, it remains a holy day of obligation, beginning this year. This is a change of past practice, whereby the obligation to attend Mass was previously lifted with the transfer of the solemnity from Sunday to Monday. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception has always been transferred to Monday when December 8 has fallen on a Sunday. But from now on, the transfer includes the obligation of the faithful to attend Mass. The Roman Catholic Church in the United States is dedicated to the patronage of Mary under the title of her Immaculate Conception. The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception is therefore the patronal fest of the U.S. Church.

*Please Note: that if you attend the 5:00PM Mass on Sunday, December 8, this does NOT fulfill the obligation for the Holy Day. You must attend another Mass on Monday, December 9.

*You may attend a regular Sunday Mass on Sunday, December 8 AND attend the 5:00PM Sunday Mass. The 5:00PM Mass would then fulfill your Holy Day obligation.


