

### THE ANGELUS PRAYER

Starting this Advent, we will begin praying the Angelus at noon on weekdays. We have reconnected our church bells and they will ring at the noon hour. This prayer began back in the 11th century as a monastic custom of praying three Hail Marys at the evening bell chime to meditate on the Incarnation. In the 15th century, a midday bell was added to pray for peace. In the 16th century, the Angelus takes its common form, repeating the words of the Annunciation. Now, the prayer continues to be a widely recited devotion, as many popes have prayed it publicly. With our noontime Mass, it seems a fitting addition to our parish. We have printed and pasted the prayer in the front of our red hymnal books so you can follow along.

# FATHER GARY PENNINGS PASTOR'S CORNER



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On this second Sunday of Advent as we continue preparing for the Lord's appearance, John the Baptist comes on the scene in the scripture readings.

John is the one who prepares the way of the Lord. He calls the children of Abraham to repent of their ways and ready their hearts for the coming Messiah. John is rather fiery and "in your face" with those who come to him only for show and lack a sincere desire to change. He is particularly direct with the Pharisees and Sadducees, calling them a "brood of vipers".

The Baptist makes a powerful statement about repentance. He says, "produce good fruit as evidence of your repentance". His point is that repentance cannot be presumptuous, but must be from the heart, with a sincere intention of changing one's ways.

The seasons of Advent and Lent both call the faithful to repentance, Lent more so than Advent. But Advent does invite us to make the necessary changes so that we are well prepared to celebrate Christmas rightly, but even more so, that we are prepared for the Lord's ultimate return, when we will see Him face-to-face.

St. Paul reminds us in the second reading from the Letter to the Romans, that what has been revealed in the scriptures is for our instruction and that we are called to endure in hope.

So, as we continue our journey through Advent, may we seek God's help in changing whatever hinders us from being prepared to encounter the Lord. May we endure in faith and in joyful hope for the coming of our Savior.

"May we be in this world a ray of that light which shone forth from Bethlehem, bringing joy and peace to the hearts of all men and women." - Pope Francis






